The main event was the in-person conference which started with a gathering of conference first-timers getting to meet and know each other through fun filled games and conversations. There was also a fun Toastmasters Bingo which required you go around the room meeting other toastmasters and seeing if they fit one of the boxes on the bingo sheet. The boxes had descriptions such as "A former District officer", "A Pathways DTM" (someone who got their DTM through the pathways learning rather than the legacy system) along with other descriptive bingo boxes. We learned to challenge those thoughts, determine if they are true or false and develop positive thoughts to counter the negative. We learned deep breathing exercises to help us calm down before we speak as well as the use of positive imagery to change our emotional state. This was a highly informative and useful training session.

The contests were a major highlight of the conference. Charisse did a great job in the evaluation contest and each evaluator was excellent. While in the end there could only be one winner, it is a great accomplishment for us that our own Charisse was one of the top five evaluators in the entire district!
